Dear Mr. Billingsley:

On July 27, 2009, I met with you and Allan Krinickas (representing the current building occupant) at the former CBM Supply Company (CBM) located at 2950 E. 55<sup>th</sup> Street in Cleveland, Ohio. I inspected the building and saw that the work required by Ohio's Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) laws had been completed except for two areas that contained waste. Ohio EPA received the Regulated Substance & Equipment Removal (90 Day-Final Form) for this facility on September 8, 2009. A letter attached to this form documented the disposal of the waste in the two areas mentioned above. As outlined below, CBM has corrected the violations previously cited and satisfactorily completed the CRO regulatory process for its former E. 55<sup>th</sup> Street facility. Please see my August 14, 2008, and January 14, 2009 letters if more information is needed regarding the below previous violations.

1. **OAC rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination**  
During my July 27, 2009 inspection, I saw that CBM had corrected this violation.
2. **OAC 3745-352-20(A)(1)(c) – CRO 30-day requirements**  
Your September 4, 2009 letter confirms that you are the contact person for this CRO which documents a correction of this violation.
3. **OAC 3745-352-20(A)(2)(g) – CRO 90-day requirements**  
This form was received by Ohio EPA on September 8, 2009 which documents a correction of this violation.
4. **OAC 3745-352-20(A)(2)(d) – CRO 90-day requirements**  
The documentation of the correction of this violation was seen during my July 27, 2009 inspection and your September 8, 2009 letter.

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5. **OAC 3745-352-20(A)(2)(c) - CRO 90-day requirements**


The form and letter received on September 8, 2009 show compliance with this rule which had not been cited as a violation.
