Dear Mr. Meek:

On January 27, 2009, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), received City Machine Technologies (CMT) response to the Agency's December 30, 2009 Notice of Violation letter. CMT submitted waste evaluation information for waste paint/solvent (waste drum photograph), sand blast media and spent fluorescent lamps.

Ohio EPA's review of this information reveals that CMT has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the December 7, 2009 inspection.

Comments:

1. The facility indicated the waste paint and solvent would be disposed on a quarterly basis. Please keep in mind that as a CESQG generator of hazardous waste (hw), the facility has no time constraints on when disposal must occur as long as the facility generates less than 220 pounds of hw per month and does not accumulate more than 2,200 pounds of hw onsite at any one time.
2. The facility indicated the universal waste lamps would be disposed on a quarterly basis. Please keep in mind that universal waste may be accumulated on-site for up to a year or longer (in order to generate a sufficient quantity for shipment).
