Dear Mr. Piccoli:

During the March 9, 2010 hazardous waste compliance inspection, Medina City was found in violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) § 3734.02 (E) and (F) for illegal disposal of hazardous waste (spent xylene and paint clean-out). As stated in my March 30, 2010 Notice of Violation letter, Ohio EPA is not calling for a closure plan to be submitted at this time describing the actions to be taken to address this issue. However, on March 26, 2010, John Palmer, Ohio EPA, DHWM, and I visited the site located at 781 W. Smith Road and were told that future plans for the garage include a building extension that would cover the area of concern.

Based on this new information, Ohio EPA would encourage the City to conduct closure activities prior to the building of the extension. This would be voluntary, but if completed could address any future liability related to the disposal of hazardous waste.

To assist you in this endeavor, I have attached an outline of items that should be included/considered when developing a plan to evaluate if there has been any environmental impact due to the disposal of the xylene waste.

Ohio EPA is willing to review and comment on a plan to assist you in this project. In addition, Ohio EPA could send you an example plan that you could use in the development of your own plan.
