On May 31, 2011, I received your response dated May 27, 2011, to my December 20, 2010, Partial Return To Compliance (PRTC) letter.

The documentation you submitted in your response included: current waste profiles, a letter to Micronutrients correcting generator ID Number, personnel training program documentation, and a contingency plan with distribution documentation. My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence indicates that Instrumatics has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations from the June 16, 2010, inspection cited as "NOT RETURNED TO COMPLIANCE" in my letter of December 20, 2010, specifically:

2. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 Waste Evaluation  
OAC Rule 3745-52-40 (C) Recordkeeping.**
4. **OAC Rule 3745-52-40 Recordkeeping**
5. **OAC Rule 3745-65-16 (A) through (D) Personnel training.**
6. **OAC Rule 3745-65-51 (A) Purpose And Implementation Of Contingency Plan**

**OAC Rule 3745-65-52 (A) through (E) Content of contingency plan.**

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The above action, in combination with the previous Partial Return to Compliance letters dated December 20, 2010 and October 28, 2010, indicates that Instrumatics has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations from the June 16, 2010, inspection.
