Dear Ms. Moyers:

On July 25, 2007, the Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management received a response to concerns regarding disposal of lamps and a well-pipe like feature with oil staining at the ground surface.

From your response it is understood that all lamps will be managed as a universal waste and sent off for recycling. In regard to the well-pipe like feature at the east side of the maintenance building, this is understood to have been a collection point for the center drain of the maintenance building. This pipe overflowed to the surface with oil. You reported that the oil stained soils were removed. Any oily stained material must be disposed as a solid waste.

Further, it is understood that this containment and another holding tank to the south for the truck wash platform were pumped by Moore Well Services, Inc. The fluid contents removed was reported as water. The quantity reported removed appears to be clarified as only 42 gallons. This company is not a recognized waste hauler. It is your responsibility to ensure all waste and spent materials are properly disposed or recycled.

Lastly, from phone conversations it is understood that truck and vehicle maintenance operations have been contracted to an offsite local automobile dealership.
