Dear Mr. Smith:

On December 24, 2007, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Hazardous Waste Management, received Component Repair Technologies' (CRT) response to the Agency's December 4, 2007 partial return to compliance (PRTC) letter. CRT submitted a copy of hazardous waste manifest #003447105, personnel training documentation, and photographs of the emergency telephone.

Ohio EPA's review of this documentation reveals CRT has abated the following violations:

2. Personnel Training, OAC rule 3745-65-16 (D)(1-3):
4. Required Equipment, OAC rule 3745-65-32(B) and 3745-65-34(A):

The following violation remains outstanding. In order to correct this violation, CRT must submit the information requested below **within 15 days** of the date of this letter:

11. Tank System, OAC rules 3745-66-91 through 100:  
**CRT remains in violation of OAC rules 3745-66-91 through 100. In order to abate this violation, the facility must submit a written assessment reviewed and certified by an independent, qualified, registered professional engineer in accordance with OAC rule 3745-66-92. Any new tank and/or ancillary equipment (defined in OAC 3745-50-10) will need to be assessed/certified by the P.E. (both the Design of the Tank in accordance with OAC 3745-66-92 (A) and Installation of the Tank in accordance with OAC 3745-66-92 (B) through (F)). The secondary containment must also be certified by the P.E. in accordance with OAC 3745-66-93.**
