Dear Mr. Kubiak:

On July 16 and July 23, 2010, this writer, representing Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management (DHWM), visited Custom Collision Center located at 695 Oberlin-Elyria Road in Elyria, Ohio to conduct a hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection (CEI). Custom Collision Center was represented by you.

On August 11, 2010, Custom Collision Center submitted documentation concerning the management and disposal of spent solvent generated from gun cleaning activities.

The purpose of the inspection was to determine Custom Collision Center's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The inspection included a review of the facility's operations and the management of wastes. Custom Collision Center was inspected for the requirements of a conditionally exempt small quantity generator (CESQG) of hazardous waste.

Based on the inspection, Ohio EPA identified the following violation:

1. **OAC rule 3745-52-11, Waste Evaluation:** Any person who generates a waste must evaluate that waste to determine if it is a hazardous waste in accordance with the criteria set forth in OAC Chapter 3745-51.

Custom Collision Center failed to evaluate spent fluorescent lamps prior to disposal as a solid waste. During the July 23, 2010 inspection, you committed to manage them as Universal Waste. Please refer to the fact sheet that was provided to you during the inspection for additional information. **This violation has been adequately abated. No further information is requested.**

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
