NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV), COLUMBIANA COUNTY**

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On March 4, 2010, this writer and Todd Surrena, representing Ohio EPA, Division of Hazardous Waste Management (DHWM), visited the former National Refractories & Minerals Corp. site located at 41738 Esterly Drive, Columbiana, Ohio. The purpose of the visit was to determine the status of operations at the site including determining the status of any hazardous waste generators at this location since portions of the facility have been sub-leased to other companies.

The following represents Ohio EPA's findings:

During the visit Ohio EPA determined that Dart Transport Inc. (Dart) operates a hazardous waste transfer facility from this location and also operates a truck maintenance garage at this location. It is our understanding that you represented Dart's interest during this visit.

On January 9, 2008, Dart notified U. S. EPA of their transporter activities and received the identification number, OHR000147033. Please note that this identification number for Dart remains with the site location address: 41738 Esterly Drive, Columbiana, OH 44408.

Upon visiting the Dart truck maintenance garage, Ohio EPA determined that Dart is generating used oil and accumulating the used oil in tanks and containers.

Ohio EPA found the following violation of Ohio's hazardous waste rules:

Dart failed to clearly label or mark containers and tanks accumulating used oil with the words "Used Oil" as required by the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-279-22(C).

Please, within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, provide me with documentation showing that all tanks and containers are clearly marked or labeled "Used Oil". The

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documentation can be in the form of digital photos sent to my attention at kris.coder@epa.state.oh.us. The photos must clearly show the markings and upon receipt of the information, Ohio EPA will issue a return to compliance letter.

An additional concern regards Dart's use of the OHD009865825 which was assigned to the Dart Trucking Co., Inc. at 61 Railroad St., Canfield, OH 44406 (Mahoning County). Since identification numbers are assigned to specific site addresses, this number is not to be used for Dart's current operation at 41738 Esterly Drive, Columbiana, OH 44408. During our conversation on Friday, March 5, I understand that Dart is applying for a new number. Please provide this number to my attention as soon as possible. If Dart plans to use the OHR number currently assigned, then Dart may need to re-notify with updated information.

Enclosed are Ohio EPA's Used Oil checklist and a revised RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification/Verification form.

2. Photographs documenting the clean-up activity.


Ohio EPA has reviewed the documentation you submitted and has determined that it is sufficient to correct the violation cited in the NOV:
