Dear Mr. Martin:

Thank you for your November 20, 2008 response to Ohio EPA's October 16, 2008 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. You submitted documentation and information including:

- Two consecutive weeks of hazardous waste accumulation area inspection log sheets including the emergency equipment inspections. Upon Ohio EPA's instructions, Delphi submitted by e-mail dated December 12, 2008, a revised version of the inspection log sheet which includes the emergency communication device (the telephone) with the emergency equipment to be tested.
- Amended pages of the facility contingency plan updated to include the current list of emergency coordinators, the order they are to be contacted and their current home addresses and home phone numbers.
- Documentation demonstrating that fork truck operators, including Tom Boone, have received training in hazardous waste management relevant to their positions as fork truck operators.

My review of this documentation reveals that Delphi has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations cited in Ohio EPA's October 16, 2008 NOV letter and is hereby returned to compliance:

OAC 3745-65-33 Testing and maintenance of equipment

OAC 3745-65-54 Amendment of contingency plan

OAC 3745-65-52 (D) Content of contingency plan


OAC 3745-65-16(A)(B)(C) Personnel training
