Dear Mr. Brown:

On January 27, 2011, Ohio EPA visited M I P, Inc. (MIP) located at 701 Jones Street, Youngstown, Ohio, to conduct a hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection (CEI).

MIP was inspected for the requirements of a large quantity generator (LQG) of hazardous waste and during this visit the following violation of Ohio's hazardous waste laws or rules was found:

MIP failed to provide and document the annual refresher training to employees as required by OAC 3745-65-16(C).

Ohio EPA followed up with a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated February 9, 2011. The above violation and one concern were noted in the NOV.

By letter dated March 8, 2011, MIP requested an extension of time to complete the annual refresher training and also, submitted satisfactory information to resolve the concern noted in the February 9, 2011 NOV.

On April 25, 2011, Ohio EPA received MIP's training records showing that the refresher training for MIP's employees has been completed for 2011. With this information, MIP has abated the violation.
