Dear Mr. Schriver:

You have failed to respond to Ohio EPA's January 10, 2011 Notice of Violation (NOV).

The following violation remains outstanding. In order to correct it you must do the following and send me all requested information **within 15 days** of the date of this letter:

**1. Hazardous Waste Determination
OAC 3745-52-11**

Any person who generates a waste in the state of Ohio...shall determine if the waste is a listed hazardous waste...

You claimed that the spent solvent and still bottoms (pucks) were a non-hazardous waste but were unable to provide documentation to demonstrate that. The MSDS for the solvent indicates the solvent contains methanol, acetone, and toluene, therefore it is a listed hazardous waste. Because it is a listed hazardous waste, the still bottoms (pucks) are also a hazardous waste.

To correct this violation, you must explain, in writing, how Maaco will manage this waste stream from now on.

Failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this communication does not relieve Maaco from the responsibility of complying with all applicable Ohio EPA laws and regulations. Please be advised that present or past instances of non-compliance can continue as subjects of pending or future enforcement actions.
