Dear Mr. Manta:

On August 1, 2011, I met with you to inspect Manico, Inc. located at 37105 Code Ave., Willoughby, Ohio. The purpose of this was to determine if Manico was in compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste and used oil laws and rules as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on the inspection, it appears Manico does not normally generate any hazardous wastes.

The following violation was found:

1. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination**

This rule requires that any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste.

Manico violated this rule by disposing of waste lamps (including fluorescent lamps) with regular trash without determining whether or not they are a hazardous waste. Fluorescent and some other types of lamps contain mercury and may contain other hazardous metals. When burned out they may be a hazardous waste. In general, waste lamps should be saved in a properly labeled and closed container (such as a cardboard box) and picked up by a lamp recycler. You stated you will now properly save waste lamps to be picked up by a lamp recycler. This documents the correction of this violation.
