Dear Mr. Gandhi:

Thank you for your October 12, 2009 response to Ohio EPA's September 22, 2009 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included a letter, photos, and a non-hazardous waste manifest.

My review of this documentation reveals that McGean-Rohco, Inc. has now abated all violations discovered during the August 24 and 25, 2009 inspection as listed below.

Violations

1. **Universal Waste Management, OAC 3745-273-13(D)(1):** Waste lamps must be contained in containers or packages that are structurally sound, adequate to prevent breakage, and are compatible with the contents of the lamps. Containers or packages must remain closed and must lack evidence of leakage, spillage or damage that could cause leakage. This violation has been abated.
2. **Universal Waste Lamp Labeling, OAC 3745-273-14(E):** Waste lamps or containers of universal waste lamps must be labeled with the words, "Universal Waste Lamps" or "Waste Lamps" or "Used Lamps". This violation has been abated.

Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve your company from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
