Dear Mr. McMahan:

On August 29, 2011, Nyall McKenna and I of the Ohio EPA's Division of Materials and Waste Management, conducted a hazardous waste complaint investigation at McMahan's Wrecking, located at 3378 W. 65th Street, Cleveland, Ohio. The purpose of our visit was to investigate a complaint received by Ohio EPA alleging that there are sloppy operations at the facility. You and Tim represented the facility during the inspection.

McMahan's main business is purchasing and scrapping wrecked cars and trucks. Some auto repair and maintenance is done on-site. We were told that fluids are not drained from the vehicles you purchase. Batteries are removed and picked up weekly by Bull Dog Battery. Aluminum rims and catalytic converters are also removed. It appears that McMahan's is a non-generator of hazardous waste.

We walked the property during the investigation and noted that there are many more cars on-site than in May 2010 when Ohio EPA had conducted a complaint investigation. During our walk through of the property and buildings we did not find any violations of the hazardous waste rules.

I have enclosed copies of the inspection checklists used for this investigation. The following violation of the used oil rules was noted:

1. **Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-279-22(C)(1); Containers and above ground tanks that are used to store used oil must be labeled with the words, "Used Oil".**

The two hundred fifty gallon tote in the repair shop was not labeled with the words "Used Oil" as it required by this rule. You labeled the used oil tank with the words "Used Oil" by placing a label on it. No further action is required regarding this violation.


