I have received your October 18, 2010 e-mail. As described below, this e-mail documents your correction of the one violation remaining from the December 4, 2009 inspection of Mika Metal Fabricating located at 4530 Hamann Parkway, Willoughby, Ohio.

1. OAC rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.
Your October 18, 2010 e-mail stated that Ferrous Processing & Trading Co. will pick up any waste from the timesaver and laser cutter. This will be recycled by melting down as scrap metal. This documents your correction of this violation.
 2. OAC rule 3745-273-13 (D) - Universal waste lamp containers.
 3. OAC rule 3745-273-14 (E) - Universal waste lamp labeling.
 4. OAC rule 3745-273-16 – Employee training for handlers of universal waste.
 5. OAC rule 3745-273-15(A) - Universal waste accumulation time limits.
 6. OAC rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.
