Dear Mr. Lagrotteria:

On July 26 and July 27, 2010, I received Murphy Brothers' responses to Ohio EPA's July 9, 2010 Notice of Violation / Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRTC) letter. Documentation submitted included waste evaluation information for the spray booth filters and a monthly inventory of hazardous waste generated at the facility. Further, Murphy Brothers indicated that the facility has obtained a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) status.

Based upon submitted documentation, Murphy Brothers has abated all violations discovered during the June 3, 2010 inspection as listed below.

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Please be advised that should Murphy Brothers generate more than 220 pounds of hazardous waste in a month or accumulate more than 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste on-site, then the facility must comply with the applicable generator requirements found in OAC rule 3745-52-34.

Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve Murphy Brothers from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
