Dear Mr. Scotton:

On December 1, 2008, the Ohio EPA received Novelis' response to the October 14, 2008 Notice of Violation letter (NOV). The Novelis response included the following attachments:

- A. Analysis of the wood block flooring
- B. Training sign in sheets
- C. Gary Scotton's HWMC Certificate of Achievement

The following violation was abated at the time of the inspection and required no further action:

1. ***Personnel Training, OAC rule 3745-65-16(C)***

The following violation remains outstanding since all of the employees did not receive the training:

2. ***Personnel Training, OAC rule 3745-65-16(A)(3)***

Please submit documentation showing that the remaining personnel have had their annual refresher training on the contingency plan. In regards to Mr. Templeton who is on extended medical leave, Ohio EPA will be able to return Novelis to compliance even if he has not returned to work by the time the other employees are trained. Ohio EPA would expect Mr. Templeton to be trained shortly after he returns to work.


Based on the submittal, it appears that Novelis has addressed the concern regarding the wood block. Ohio EPA would still encourage you to re-characterize the Stage 3 sludge.
