Dear Mr. Butchko:

On March 7, 2007, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received Nutron Nameplate's response to the Agency's February 7, 2007 Notice of Violation letter. Nutron Nameplate submitted the following documentation: a copy and photograph of the facility emergency posting; a photograph of the emergency telephone; a written emergency equipment schedule and completed checklist; waste analysis documentation; and a description of the management procedures for the etch rinse waters, spent caustic, and spent acid.

Ohio EPA's review of this documentation reveals that Nutron Nameplate has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the February 1, 2007 inspection.

Nutron Nameplate should conduct periodic waste evaluations of the caustic rinse water. If the caustic rinse water has a pH of greater than or equal to 12.5 (i.e. D002 hazardous waste), the facility is required to comply with the hazardous waste Tank System Requirements if accumulated and treated in the 220-gallon tanks; and the Generator Treatment Standards when combining with acid rinse water. The pH of the combined caustic and acid rinse water should also be evaluated to ensure it remains within Agmet's limits for reuse material. The facility should ensure safety precautions are followed when mixing acidic and caustic materials.
