Thank you for your June 22, 2011 response to Ohio EPA's May 24, 2011 Notice of Violation (NOV). The documentation you submitted included an explanation that you will dispose of the still bottoms, as a hazardous waste, through Phillips Environmental and you will use American Lighting to handle burned out fluorescent lamps.

This explanation is sufficient to correct the violation cited in the NOV and the concern regarding fluorescent lamps:
