On May 18, 2011, I received Plating Perceptions, Inc. (PPI's) response to Ohio EPA's April 18, 2011 Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRTC) letter. The following is the status of the previously cited violations:

1. Labeling & Dating Accumulation Containers, OAC rule 3745-52-34 (A)(2)&(3): This violation was previously abated.
2. Personnel Training, OAC rule 3745-65-16(C): PPI's May 18, 2011 response included documentation that facility personnel received training on hazardous waste management and emergency response procedures. This training was conducted on May 13, 2011. **Based upon submitted documentation, this violation has been adequately abated. No further response is necessary.**
3. Content of Contingency Plan, OAC rule 3745-65-52(D): PPI's May 18, 2011 response included an updated contingency plan. **Based upon submitted documentation, this violation has been adequately abated. No further response is necessary.** Please be aware that the contingency plan must be distributed to emergency authorities in accordance with OAC rule 3745-65-53(B).

Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve PPI from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
