Thank you for your August 8, 2008 response to Ohio EPA's July 10, 2008 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. You submitted information and documentation including:

1. Copies of hazardous waste manifests #003827589 JJK and #003171367 JJK demonstrating that PPG has retained copies of the signed manifests for its records.
2. A copy of hazardous waste #003827202 JJK demonstrating that the rejected load of chloroformate waste was properly manifested off site to Ross Incineration for proper disposal.
3. A copy of the new written lab pack procedure.
4. A discussion regarding labeling procedures in the HWSB.
5. A discussion regarding the completion of forms and checklists.
6. A statement from PPG indicating that the facility will continue the use of the balance sheets in the HWSB as a waste tracking measure.

My review of this documentation reveals that PPG has adequately abated the following hazardous waste violation:


PPG has also adequately addressed all concerns cited in Ohio EPA's July 10, 2008 NOV. PPG is hereby returned to compliance.
