**RE: PPG INDUSTRIES, INC. (BARBERTON, PLANT), RCRA/LQG, OHD 004 198 917, OHIO
ID# 02-77-0453, SUMMIT COUNTY, COMPLIANCE EVALUATION INSPECTION, NOTICE
OF VIOLATION/RETURN TO COMPLIANCE**

On June 10, 2010, Ohio EPA conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of PPG Industries, Inc. (PPG) located at 4829 Fairland Road, Ohio. PPG manufactures specialty chemicals and synthetic paper products and is a Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (TSD) operating under its September 30, 1993 Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operating Permit (permit). PPG is also a large quantity generator of hazardous waste. The purpose of this inspection was to determine PPG's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found under the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code ("ORC" and "OAC" respectively), and with PPG's permit. PPG was represented by Irene Raiber and Randy Brillhart while Ohio EPA was represented by me. This inspection included an inspection of the PPG facility, the permitted Hazardous Waste Storage Building (HWSB), and a review of documentation.

Based upon this inspection, Ohio EPA has determined that PPG has violated the following hazardous waste regulation:

1. **OAC Rule 3745-273-13(D)(1) Universal Waste Lamp Management:**
*A small quantity handler of universal waste must contain any lamp in containers or packages that are structurally sound, adequate to prevent breakage, and compatible with the contents of the lamps. **Such containers and packages must remain closed** and must lack evidence of leakage, spillage, or damage that could cause leakage under reasonably foreseeable conditions.*

At the time of the June 10, 2010 inspection, Ohio EPA observed one container of eight foot universal waste lamps being accumulated in an open container.

Upon being informed of this violation, PPG immediately abated the violation by closing the container of universal waste lamps. Ohio EPA therefore considers this violation abated and no further action is required.

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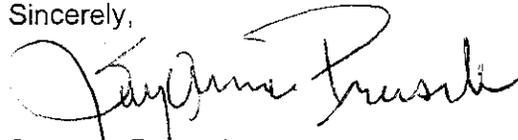
