Dear Mr. DeRose:

On November 30, 2010, and January 20, 2011, I sent you letters requesting that you address four outstanding violations from our September 29, 2010 hazardous waste inspection. I had not received a response from you since my November 30th letter so I called you on March 2, 2011, to discuss the status of the items cited. You verbally confirmed that all totes containing used oil are labeled "used oil" as illustrated in the photo submitted on November 18, 2010. You also confirmed that spent lamps are placed in properly labeled containers that are stored closed as also illustrated in another photo submitted November 18, 2010. Documentation of universal waste and used oil training was e-mailed to me March 2, 2011, after our phone conversation.

Based on this information, you have addressed all violations cited from our September 29, 2010, hazardous waste inspection. Your facility is considered to have returned to compliance with all rules cited in my October 19, 2010 letter. Thank you for your cooperation.
