On November 30, 2010, I sent you a letter requesting that you address four outstanding violations from our September 29, 2010 hazardous waste inspection. I have not received a response from you since my November 30th letter. Again the violations and requested responses are as follows.

1. **Used Oil Container Labels - OAC 3745-279-22(C)**
Please confirm that all totes containing used oil are labeled "used oil".
2. **Spent Lamp Containers- OAC 3745-273-13(D)(1)**
Please confirm all spent lamps upon generation are placed into the appropriate container and that the container is stored closed.
3. **Unlabelled Spent Lamps - OAC 3745-273-14(E)**
The photo submitted documents that proper labeling is present on the lamp recycling container. Please confirm all spent lamps upon generation are placed into the container shown in the photograph and that the container is stored closed.
4. **Employee Training - OAC 3745-273-16**
Your employees are required to be informed of proper handling or management of universal waste lamps. Please confirm that all employees involved in the management of spent lamps have been informed of their proper management.

Please submit the above requested confirmations within 10 days of the date of this letter.
