Dear Mr. Kungl:

You were sent a Notice of Violation dated September 18, 2008, for a violation of Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management (DHW) rules. A complaint alleged that oils were being dumped onto the ground and in parking areas. Your facility and the area of concern were inspected for compliance with Ohio hazardous waste laws found in chapters 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The allegation appears unfounded, however some oil staining was observed by your dumpster.

Violation

There was an area of oil-stained gravel at your dumpster. **OAC 3745-279-22(D)** requires such releases of oil to the environment to be cleaned up and properly managed and disposed. Based on the oil used at your facility it appears that oil stained floor sweepings, cleanup of oil stained gravels and oily dri-sorb material may be disposed as a solid waste. In the future, be sure that the oily debris that you manage for disposal is completely absorbed prior to placement in your dumpster.

Contaminated used oils that you can not recycle on site may be managed onsite by labeling as "Used Oil" and sent offsite for recycling. A list of facilities that take used oils and a guidance fact sheet for the management of used oils was provided in the September 18, 2008 letter.

To return to compliance from this violation, please provide written documentation or a photograph to Ohio EPA showing that this area has been cleaned up.
