Thank you for your correspondence dated January 21, 2010 and received on January 25, 2010 responding to Ohio EPA's NOV letter dated December 28, 2009.

Sheffield Bronze Paint Corporation submitted documentation consisting of a letter to your plant supervisor addressing future practices for labeling and dating hazardous waste containers, management of used motor oil, and recycling of used fluorescent lamps.

My review of this documentation indicates Sheffield Bronze Paint Corporation has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations from the December 10, 2009 inspection cited in my letter of December 28, 2009, specifically:

1. **OAC Rule 3745 52-34(C)(1)(b) Must mark satellite accumulation containers with the words Hazardous Waste or other words that identify the contents**  
**OAC Rule 3745 52-66-73(A) Satellite accumulation containers must be closed except when adding or removing waste**
2. **OAC Rule 3745-52-34(C)(2) Must mark date when container is full on satellite accumulation containers and within 3 days move to 180 day accumulation area.**  
**OAC Rule 3745-52-34(A)(2) Accumulation start date (i.e. date moved into 180 day area) must be clearly marked on containers in 180 day accumulation area.**  
**OAC Rule 3745-52-34(A)(3) Containers in 180 day accumulation area must be labeled with the words hazardous waste.**
3. **OAC Rule 3745 279-72(A) Used oil marketer must ensure used oil meets specs by proper documents**
4. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 Waste Evaluation**
