Dear Mr. Shondrick:

On August 18, 2009 I met with you at your facility in follow-up to your submittal received July 29, 2009 in response to Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management's Notice of Violation letter dated July 1, 2009.

Your submittal included photographs showing that three oil stained ground and gravel areas had been cleaned up. You confirmed the oily stained waste was disposed as a solid waste and provided pictures showing proper labeling of "used oil" containers with a receipt showing the removal of oily water. From the site visit, I confirmed that drums where releases had occurred were removed to inside storage, emptied, or the contents transferred into good containers. During the site visit you also presented a copy of an SPCC plan for your new Above Ground Fuel tank and containment system.

Your submittal was adequate to demonstrate that all identified violations of Ohio's hazardous waste regulations appear to have been abated as of July 29, 2009 including:

1. OAC 3745-279-22(D): Response to Releases of Used Oil.

CONCERNS and RECOMENDATIONS


From the August 18, 2009 site visit it is understood that:

1. Used oil containers will be managed indoors and will otherwise be kept in closed and labeled containers that are periodically inspected for leaks or releases.
2. Fluorescent and high intensity discharge lamps will be managed as a universal waste and sent for recycling.

3. A Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) plan had been prepared for the site. It is recommended that you and facility employees, who may need to implement the plan, be thoroughly familiar with plan requirements and needed maintenance operations.
