Dear Mr. Dickson:

Thank you for your November 13, 2007, and December 4, 2007 response to Ohio EPA's September 13, 2007 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. You submitted information and documentation, including:

- One photograph demonstrating that the F006 hazardous waste is being managed in closed and a labeled container.
- One close up photograph demonstrating that the container of F006 has been labeled with the words hazardous waste and an accumulation date.
- Information and documentation demonstrating that the universal waste lamps which had been on site in excess of one year have been shipped off site to Bethlehem Lamp Recycling.
- Two photographs demonstrating that the universal waste lamps are being managed in boxes which are labeled, dated and kept closed.
- One photograph demonstrating that the F006 hazardous waste is being collected in a hopper under the filter press and then shoveled into the container.
- A copy of the 2005 Annual Hazardous Waste report submitted to Ohio EPA's Central Office.
- Documentation demonstrating that the fifty-five gallon drum containing a transformer suspected to contain PCB's has been shipped off-site to Harrington Electric.


