**RE: STAR COMPLETE AUTO SERVICE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, COMPLAINT #7318,
RETURN TO COMPLIANCE**

Dear Mr. Wolf

Thank you for your October 29, 2010 response to Ohio EPA's October 18, 2010 Notice of Violation letter (NOV). You submitted information and documentation including:

- Documentation from Environmental Specialists, dated September 15, 2010, demonstrating the oil in the vehicle lift pits has been removed and shipped off site for recycling.
- Documentation from Northeast Construction, dated September 23, 2010, indicating the vehicle lift pits have backfilled with stone and concrete.

One November 19, 2010, Ohio EPA visited Star Complete Auto Service in order to document photographically the backfilled vehicle lift pits. Ohio EPA took three (3) photographs of the filled pits which will be added to the facility file.

My review of this documentation reveals Star Complete Auto Service has adequately abated the following violation cited in Ohio EPA's October 18, 2010 NOV, and is hereby returned to compliance:

3745-279-22 Used Oil Storage requirements for generators:

Failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve Star Complete Auto Services from the responsibility of complying with all applicable hazardous waste regulations. This letter does not relieve Star Complete Auto Services from liability for any past or present violations of the state's hazardous waste laws.
