On May 4, 2007, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), received Summit Environmental Technologies' (Summit) response to the Agency's April 20, 2007 NOV letter.

In order to correct the outstanding violations, Summit must do the following and send me the required information **within 15 days** of the date of this letter:

1. Waste Evaluation, OAC rule 3745-52-11, Expired Samples:
Summit submitted a revised Hazardous Waste SOP to address this violation.

Summit has addressed this violation and no further response is required.

19. Personnel Training, OAC rules 3745-65-16(A)(1-3), (B), (D)(1-4) and (E):
Summit submitted documentation demonstrating Jim Miller, Bachar Najem, and Bassam Youssef received training on hazardous waste management and emergency procedures listed in the contingency plan. The remaining employees did not receive training and were only provided a copy of the contingency plan.

Summit also submitted job titles/descriptions required by OAC rules 3745-65-16(D)(1-4) for Jim Miller, Bachar Najem, and Bassam Youssef. No additional job titles/descriptions were provided.

In order to abate this violation, Summit must submit the following information:


- **Documentation demonstrating laboratory personnel have received training on hazardous waste management and emergency procedures listed in the contingency plan (i.e. additional employees who place hazardous waste into satellite accumulation containers inside the facility);**
- **Job titles/descriptions required by OAC rule 3745-65-16(D)(1-4) for additional laboratory personnel (i.e. additional employees who place hazardous waste into satellite accumulation containers inside the facility); and**

- **Revised job titles/descriptions for Jim Miller and Bachar Najem stating the amount of both introductory and continuing training that will be provided.**
