I have received your November 2, 2007 letter, revisions to your contingency plan, information from Philips Lighting, and a disc of photographs. These were in response to the violations and concerns found during the September 17, 2007 inspection of Art Galvanizing located at 3935 Valley Road, Cleveland, Ohio. You have corrected all the violations and addressed all the concerns as outlined below.

Violations:

1. OAC rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.
Your letter and the information from Philips Lighting documents your correction of this violation.
2. OAC rule 3745-65-52(E) – Contingency plan emergency equipment.
The revisions to your contingency plan document your correction of this violation.
3. OAC rule 3745-65-31 – Maintenance and operation of facility.
Your letter and the enclosed photographs document your correction of this violation.
4. OAC rule 3745-52-34(C)(1)(a) – Satellite accumulation area.
Your letter and the enclosed photographs document your correction of this violation.
5. OAC rule 3745-52-34(C)(1)(b) – Satellite accumulation area.
Your letter and the enclosed photographs document your correction of this violation.

Concerns:

1. You have addressed this concern by adding containers to collect the waste as it comes out of the air pollution control unit.
