Dear Mr. Competty:

On December 31, 2007, the Ohio EPA received MK Morse's response to the December 5, 2007 notice of violation letter (NOV). The MK Morse response included the following attachments:

- A. Job title and description for the Process/Environmental Engineer
- B. Job title and description for the Traffic Manager
- C. Job title and description for the Assistant Traffic Manager

As stated in the NOV, MK Morse had adequately addressed the following violations at the time of the inspection and no further action was required:

3. ***Labeling/marketing- standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste, OAC rule 3745-273-14(E)***
4. ***Accumulation time limits – standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste, OAC rule 3745-273-15(C)***
5. ***Packaging of Universal Waste Lamps, OAC rule 3745-273-13(D)(1)***

Based on the information submitted, it appears that MK Morse has adequately addressed the following violation:

2. ***Personnel Training, OAC rule 3745-65-16(D)(2)***

You state that a representative sample of the floor sweepings has been collected and that the results of the analysis will be submitted to Ohio EPA. Until these results are received, MK Morse will remain in violation of the following violation from the NOV:

1. ***Waste Evaluation, OAC 3745-52-11***

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Ohio EPA also noted several concerns in the NOV.

Item #6 was in regards to the confidentiality of the map received during the inspection. My attorney, Todd Anderson will be e-mailing you with the apparent deficiencies of the confidentiality request.

It appears MK Morse has or will be addressing the waste characterization concerns noted in item #7.

Failure to list specific deficiencies and or violations in this communication does not relieve MK Morse from the responsibility of complying with all applicable laws, rules and regulations.

Further be advised that any instances of non-compliance can continue as subjects of pending or future enforcement actions.

Please respond to this letter in writing by February 10, 2008, and provide the waste characterization. Should you have any questions or require additional information, please contact Frank Popotnik, my supervisor, or me at (330) 963-1200.
