Thank you for your September 2, 2011 response to Ohio EPA's June 27, 2011 Notice of Violation (NOV). Your response was received via e-mail. The documentation you submitted included the following:

1. Photographs of labeled used oil containers in room 714, Polymer Sciences Building and the Machine Shop, Auburn Science Building.
2. Copies of documents showing an outline of RCRA/hazardous waste refresher training and an attendance sheet signed by the attendees. The training was provided on September 1, 2011.

The documentation is sufficient to correct the two outstanding violations cited in the NOV:

5. **Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators (Labels)**  
**OAC 3745-279-22(C)**
7. **Personnel Training Requirements**  
**OAC 3745-65-16(C)**

No response to this letter is required.

Failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve University of Akron from the responsibility of complying with all applicable Ohio EPA laws and regulations. Please be advised that present or past instances of non-compliance can continue as subjects of pending or future enforcement actions.
