Dear Mr. Savaet:

On July 19, 2007, Ohio EPA received a response to a Notice of Violation letter dated June 27, 2007. The response indicated that all containers were labeled and that the oil stained soils had been removed and containerized. Oily stained waste must be disposed to a solid waste landfill. You must ensure that all wastes are properly characterized to ensure proper disposal. From review of the information you submitted, the following violations appear to have been abated.

1. OAC 3745-279-22(C)(2), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators (Labels)
2. OAC 3745-279-22(D), Response to Releases of Used Oil.

You stated your lamps will be taken by B&J Electric. You must ensure all wastes and spent material are properly disposed or recycled.
