Thank you for your March 16, 2011, response to Ohio EPA's February 10, 2011, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included photographic documentation demonstrating the posting of emergency information, the spill control equipment purchased, and the oil storage tank with a "used oil" label. Also submitted was a completed emergency equipment and container accumulation area inspection log.

My review of this documentation reveals that United Truck Wash has now abated all violations discovered during the January 27, 2011, inspection as listed below.
