Dear Mr. Coburn:

On November 19, 2007, Gary Deutschman and I investigated a complaint at Rite Way Auto (RWA) located at 425 Findlay Road, Lima, Ohio. According to the complaint received by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), the complainant alleged that RWA had an oil spill. This letter will explain the validity of the complaint, the violation found at the facility, what was done to correct the violation, other general concerns found at the facility, and what you need to do to respond to our concerns.

RWA purchases used automobiles, conducts minor repairs on these automobiles, and then sells these automobiles for profit. Used oil is generated at this facility.

Complaint

Upon Ohio EPA's arrival to the site, we spoke with the secretary, Tami Bushong. She explained that you were the business owner, but were not currently on site. Tami stated that she was not aware of an oil spill at the property and she gave us permission to walk around the site. Ohio EPA did not find any evidence of an oil spill at the property. As such, I have found no evidence to substantiate the complaint allegation. This complaint is considered closed.

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Violation

As a result of the complaint investigation, Ohio EPA found the following violation of Ohio's used oil regulations:

1. **Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-279-22 (C)(1), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators:** "Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities must be labeled or marked clearly with the words 'Used Oil.'"

RWA failed to mark their used oil drum located behind the building with the words "Used Oil."

RWA marked the used oil drum with the words "Used Oil" while Ohio EPA was on site.

Therefore, this violation was abated on November 19, 2007.

General Concerns

- A. **Used Oil:** According to OAC Rule 3745-279-24, titled *Off-site shipments of used oil by generators*, "generators must ensure that their used oil is transported only by transporters who have obtained U.S. EPA identification numbers." Used oil generators have three options for handling their used oil: 1) Generators must have their used oil transported by an entity that has a U.S. EPA identification number and ensure their used oil is recycled; 2) Generators may transport less than 55-gallons of their own used oil to a registered used oil collection center; or 3) Generators may burn its own used oil in an on-site space heater as long as all applicable requirements are met.

During the inspection I spoke with your employees about the used oil. They stated that you handled the used oil and they were not aware of what happens to it.

To determine your compliance with respect to the used oil regulations, RWA must submit information concerning the disposal of the used oil. RWA must explain how the used oil is transported, the name and address of the facility the used oil is taken to, what the facility does with the used oil, how much used oil is generated by RWA per month, and how long the used oil has been handled in

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this fashion. **RWA must submit this information to Ohio EPA's Northwest District Office within 14 days of receipt of this letter.**

For more information on used oil, I have enclosed the used oil fact sheet titled The Regulation of Used Oil: An Overview for Ohio Businesses Who Generate Used Oil, April 2006.

- B. Storage Trailers:** On the east side of the building, Ohio EPA noticed two trailers in decent condition that had locks on the doors. Ohio EPA is unsure what is stored in these trailers.

RWA must submit a general description of the contents of these trailers. **RWA must submit this information to Ohio EPA's Northwest District Office within 14 days of receipt of this letter. Also, RWA must contact me, at the number listed below, to arrange a meeting time at the facility to observe the contents of the trailers.**

For other valuable information, I have also included the Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention's March 2007 guide titled Environmental Compliance Guide for Auto Repair Shops and the fact sheet Universal Waste Rules for Handlers of Lamps dated June 2005. Please be advised that a full compliance evaluation inspection was not conducted at this facility. Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve you from having to comply with all applicable regulations.

Ohio EPA will issue an EPA ID number to track our inspection activity at RWA. RWA can not use this number for manifesting hazardous waste shipments. If RWA wants to use an EPA ID number for manifesting and other hazardous waste, used oil or universal waste activities, RWA must complete and submit a Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form (EPA Form 9029 (Rev. 11/2002)) to Ohio EPA. This form is available on our Web page at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dhwm/notiform.html> or RWA can call the Division of Hazardous Waste Management, Central Office, RIS at (614) 644-2977 and a copy will be sent through the mail.


