Dear Mr. Whitaker:

Thank you for your February 26, 2007, response to my February 7, 2007, Notice of Violation letter. Your response included documentation that you have contracted with Philip Services to remove your hazardous waste. You indicated that you generated about 30 gallons of hazardous waste which would make you a small quantity generator for the month that the waste determination was made. As a small quantity generator, you will have 180 days to ship the hazardous waste off-site to a permitted hazardous waste treatment, storage or disposal facility. For the 30-gallons of hazardous waste you generated on January 3, you will have until July 2, 2007 to have it shipped off-site. You are subject to the small quantity generator rules while this waste is on-site. The rules can be found online at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dhwm>.


In your response, you also provided analytical for the shot dust that is taken by OmniSource for recycling. The analytical showed that the waste is non-hazardous. You should also have the shot dust cartridges analyzed before you ship them off-site to document that they are non-hazardous. You should keep a copy of this analytical on file as well in case you are inspected in the future.

With the information received by Ohio EPA on February 26, 2007, Bethel Engineering has abated the Waste Evaluation violation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11, found during our January 3, 2007, compliance inspection.
