Dear Mr. Hoying:

I received your July 3, July 9, and August 6, 2007, responses to Ohio EPA's June 6, 2007, Second Partial Return to Compliance letter, January 5, 2007, First Partial Return to Compliance letter and February 17, 2006, Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including: photographs of labeled and dated universal waste lamps, a narrative of waste sampling at the plant, analytical results of waste paint sampling, sampling chain of custody, a training plan and documentation that training was completed for all painters and waste handlers.

After sampling and analysis, based on the analytical results you provided, your waste paint and cleaning solvents should have the following hazardous waste numbers: F003, F005, D035 & D018.

My review of this documentation reveals that Fabcor has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during my February 7, 2006, inspection.

The following violations have been abated:

1. OAC Rule 3745-52-11 Waste Evaluation (Corrected on August 6, 2007)
2. ORC Section 3734.02(E)&(F) Unpermitted Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal (Corrected on August 6, 2007)
3. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C) Container Labeling (Corrected on March 10, 2006)

Ohio EPA considers the violations cited in the February 17, 2006, Notice of Violation letter to be serious violations. If these violations are observed in the future, Ohio EPA may pursue further enforcement action.
