Dear Mr. Eaglowski:

Thank you for your February 16, May 14 and May 29, 2009, responses to Ohio EPA's December 5, 2008, Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including a description of your new universal waste procedures for spent lamps, a photograph of a properly labeled drum of used oil, photographs of the scraped and cleaned oil contaminated pavement, a photo of a properly labeled and dated container of universal waste lamps and the analytical report for the oil contaminated absorbent.

My review of the documentation reveals that on May 14, 2009, St. Marys Foundry (SMF) had adequately demonstrated abatement of its violation of **OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Waste Evaluation** for the universal waste lamps. On February 16, 2009, SMF had adequately demonstrated abatement of its violation of **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C), Used Oil Container Labeling**. On May 29, 2009, SMF had adequately demonstrated abatement of its violation of **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D), Response to Releases of Used Oil**. Therefore, SMF has abated all the violations discovered during my October 6, 2008, inspection.

In addition, on March 12, 2009, Ohio EPA conducted sampling of the spent sand and refractory at your facility. The materials sampled included spent materials discarded in your on-site landfill. Ohio EPA received the results of this sampling on March 30, 2009. According to the analytical report of Brookside Laboratories Inc., none of the spent materials possessed a characteristic of hazardous waste.
