Dear Mr. South:

The Southeast District Office of the Ohio EPA has received a complaint that illegal disposal of demolition debris is occurring on property that you may own, located off of Sherwood Black Road, in Adams County, Ohio. The demolition debris appears to be from a razed mobile home that exists on the property.

I conducted an inspection of the property on April 20, 2010, and observed demolition debris dumped on your property. This would include insulation that is blowing and scattered about the property. No one was home on this inspection. I was accompanied by Jason Work with the Adams County Health Department.

Illegal disposal of demolition debris is a violation of Chapter 3714 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745-27 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Specifically:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Presently, you are in violation of the above referenced rules.

Illegal disposal of demolition debris must cease immediately. All demolition debris disposed at the described location must be removed from the property and taken to a licensed solid waste disposal facility for proper disposal. Obtain copies of receipts from the landfill that received the waste and provide those copies to this district office in order to document your compliance. I suggest that you obtain the services of a registered waste hauler to assist you in your waste disposal.

The disposal facilities located nearest to you in Ohio is the Pike Sanitation Landfill at 11775 State Route 220, Waverly, Ohio; the Rumpke Landfill in Georgetown, Ohio; the Portsmouth Exempt Transfer Station, located on Elm Street in Portsmouth, Ohio. You may choose to use other permitted and licensed facilities.
