Thank you for your May 12, 2008 & July 1, 2008, responses to Ohio EPA's August 2, 2007, Notice of Violation letter. On May 12, 2008, you submitted to me via email your universal waste management plan for your fluorescent bulbs and on July 1, 2008, you submitted, via fax, analytical indicating your paint booth filters were non-hazardous. In addition, on July 15, 2008, I spoke with Allison Lauf, Compliance Manager of Clean Water Ltd, pertaining to your analytical results. Ms. Lauf stated that the paint booth filters contained no free liquid, were 100% solid with no flash or flame.

My review of this documentation reveals that Beverage Body & Trailer Service has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the July 19, 2007, investigation as listed below:
