Dear Mr. Brown:

Thank you for your response to my June 7, 2011, Notice of Violation letter. Your June 17, 2011, response included certified receipts and cover letters showing that you have submitted contingency plans to all local emergency responders.

The following is a summary of the violations observed during my May 18, 2011, inspection:

1. **Annual Refresher Training for Personnel, OAC Rule 3745-65-16(C):**

This violation was previously abated on May 18, 2011

2. **Labeling of Used Oil, OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1):**

This violation was previously abated on May 18, 2011

3. **Copies of Contingency Plan, OAC Rule 3745-65-53:**

A copy of the contingency plan and all revisions to the plan shall be maintained at the facility and submitted to all local police departments, fire departments, hospitals, and any local response team(s) that may be requested to provide emergency services. JM had not submitted copies to the proper entities listed above.

On June 17, 2011, Johns Manville submitted copies of cover letters and certified mail receipts showing that the contingency plan was sent to Defiance Fire Department, Defiance City Police, Defiance Hospital and Defiance Mercy Hospital. Therefore, this violation is considered abated.

Johns Manville, Plant 8, has abated all violations cited during Ohio EPA's May 18, 2011, hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection.
