Dear Ms. Righi:

On September 15, 2009, I inspected the Sandusky Register's facility located at 314 West Market Street in Sandusky, Ohio. I inspected Sandusky Register to determine the facility's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). As a result of the September 15, 2009, inspection, Sandusky Register was issued a notice of violation (NOV) letter dated September 29, 2009. On December 10, 2009, I scanned and e-mailed a copy of the September 29, 2009, NOV letter to you. On January 21, 2010, Sandusky Register was issued a second NOV letter for failure to respond to the first NOV letter. Ohio EPA and Sandusky Register have been corresponding via email since the date of the second NOV letter. On April 21, 2010, I visited the facility to discuss the status of the NOV letter.

Wastes generated at the facility include non-hazardous biodegradable parts washer solvent from one parts washer located in the production area, used gear and compressor oils from the production area, soy based oils/inks from the press area, contaminated cloth rags from the press area and fluorescent lighting from throughout the facility. All liquid wastes generated at the facility are managed in drums and disposed through Safety Kleen. Contaminated cloth rags are laundered by Cintas. Spent fluorescent lighting is managed as universal waste and recycled by Environmental Recycling. Sandusky Register is not currently a generator of hazardous waste.

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After visiting the facility on April 21, 2010, I reviewed documentation and have determined that Sandusky Register has abated all violations discovered during the September 15, 2009, inspection as listed below.

In addition to the above violations, Sandusky Register must address the following General comment:

1. To improve recordkeeping, Sandusky Register should designate an employee to maintain material safety data sheets, purchase records, and waste disposal receipts. These records should be maintained in an easily identifiable and recoverable location.
