Thank you for your January 11, 2010, response to Ohio EPA's December 11, 2009, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included analytical data for the spent paint filters used in your body shop and documentation demonstrating that you are now managing your spent fluorescent lamps as universal waste.

My review of this documentation reveals that Rich Ford Lincoln Mercury has abated all violations discovered during the November 30, 2009, inspection as listed below.

GENERAL COMMENTS


1. Based on the analytical data provided to the Ohio EPA, it appears that the spent paint filters may be managed as a solid non-hazardous waste.

2. Rich Ford Lincoln Mercury must store universal waste lamps in a **closed** and labeled **container**. This container must be properly **labeled** with the wording "**Universal Waste Lamp(s)**", "**Waste Lamp(s)**", or "**Used Lamp(s)**". Rich Ford Lincoln Mercury must also track the accumulation of the spent lamps to ensure spent lamps are not stored for greater than 365 days. This can be accomplished with recycling receipts or by marking the container with the accumulation start date (the day the first spent lamp is placed in the container).
