Thank you for your September 8, 2011, response to Ohio EPA's August 24, 2011, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). You submitted an email which stated that you will be managing your fluorescent bulbs as universal waste which includes recycling your bulbs and you will transport no more than 55-gallons of your used oil in your company vehicle to a registered used oil collection center.


My review of this documentation reveals that Bluffton Flying Service has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the August 4, 2011, inspection as listed below:
