Dear Mr. Camden:

On July 21, 2010, I contacted you regarding Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation (NOV) letter which was sent to The Findlay Courier on April 7, 2010. I called you to confirm how you will be managing your spent fluorescent lamps and also your used oil. You stated that you will be using Environmental Recycling to recycle your lamps. You also stated that the used oil, approx. 1-gallon per month, will be mixed in with your press wash which is taken by Safety-Kleen. We reviewed the used oil material safety data sheet during our inspection. As a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator, you may mix used oil and press wash prior it being taking off-site by Safety-Kleen.

The following is a summary of the violations cited in the April 7, 2010, NOV as a result of our March 24, 2010, inspection and your compliance with respect to each:

1. OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Waste Evaluation:

The Courier confirmed during our inspection and during our telephone conversation on July 21, 2010, that fluorescent lamps will be managed as universal waste by Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green, Ohio. As stated in our fact sheet given to you during our inspection, you **MUST** containerize the lamps, label, date, and recycle spent lamps within one year. Ohio EPA may check for compliance in the future.

Therefore, this violation is considered abated.

2. OAC Rule 3745-279-24, Used Oil - Off-Site Shipment:

The Courier will be shipping the used oil off-site to Safety Kleen to be used for energy recovery. This information was given during our telephone conversation on July 21, 2010.

Therefore, this violation is considered abated.

3. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1), Used Oil Labeling:


