Thank you for your December 29, 2008, response (received in this office on December 31, 2008) to Ohio EPA's December 3, 2008, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). Your response stated you will be managing your lamps as universal waste and recycling your lamps with Environmental Recycling. In addition, you submitted three photographs documenting that your used oil drain pans have been properly labeled.

My review of this documentation reveals that Oiler's Lube Express has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the November 25, 2008, inspection as listed below:
