Thank you for submitting via email the requested information received by Ohio EPA on January 14 and March 4, 2011. You submitted this information in response to my November 8, 2010, Notice of Violation Letter. In your response, you included a copy of the paint booth filters sampling results, a statement indicating that you will be managing your spent light bulbs as universal waste and that they will be sent to Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green, Ohio, and photographs showing the proper labeling of containers of used oil. According to the sampling results, you will be managing the used paint filters as solid waste.

My review of this documentation reveals that Troxel's Body Shop has abated the violations discovered during the October 28, 2010, compliance evaluation inspection as listed below:
