Dear Mr. Bruskotter:

Thank you for your May 1, 2009, December 4, 2009, and February 5, 2010, responses to Ohio EPA's March 31, 2009, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). The responses included analytical information indicating that the used oil you transport and utilize in your on-site used oil burner is on-specification; that you will manage your fluorescent bulbs as universal waste and recycle with Environmental Recycling; and that you have resumed transporting your used oil but are not transporting used oil between generators, only from the generator to your facility for burning, respectively.

My review of this documentation reveals that University of Findlay, South Campus has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the March 10, 2009, inspection as listed below:

In addition, all Areas of Concern were satisfied with your response submitted on May 1, 2009 and February 5, 2010. Please note that, as the Used Oil Marketer, you must ensure to keep on-site at your facility all records of shipments and analysis of used oil picked up. When I conducted the inspection on March 10, 2009, you were keeping all records of pick-ups. Please continue to do so and likewise ensure that South Campus has a copy of the used oil analysis at their location. In addition, you must ensure that all generators of used oil where University of Findlay is making pickups, have a copy on-site at their respective facilities of the analysis conducted (of their used oil generated) to determine this oil was on-specification.
