Dear Mr. Warrington:

Thank you for your response to Ohio EPA's June 14, 2007, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). On July 13, 2007, you submitted photograph documentation indicating your used lamp containers have been closed and properly labeled. In addition, you submitted a statement indicating the circumstances around why you had not submitted your 2006 Hazardous waste annual report and stated this report had been submitted to Ohio EPA.

In addition, on August 16, 2007, I observed your 2006 Hazardous waste annual report in our database indicating this report was in fact submitted.

My review of this documentation reveals that Whirlpool Corporation has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the May 31, 2007, compliance evaluation inspection (CEI) as listed below:

1. OAC Rule 3745-273-13 (D) (1), Waste management - standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste (lamps). ***This violation was abated with the July 13, 2007, response.***
2. OAC Rule 3745-273-14 (E), Waste management - Labeling/marketing standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste (lamps). ***This violation was abated with the July 13, 2007, response.***
3. OAC 3745-279-22 (C) (1), Used oil storage requirements - proper labels. ***This violation was abated during the May 31, 2007, CEI.***

Whirlpool Corporation has also satisfied the area of concern noted in the June 14, 2007, NOV.


